My virtual or in-person author presentations explore the wonders of science and the process of researching, writing, revising, and illustrating a book. **For younger children**, I focus on the fun of reading, story-making, and animals (with puppets!). **For older children** I dive deeper into the science, the research process (with fossils!), and narrative structure.

OUT OF THE BLUE: HOW ANIMALS EVOLVED FROM PREHISTORIC SEAS (Candlewick Press, May 2021). With gorgeous illustrations by Frann Preston-Gannon, this award-winning, starred-review picture book takes kids on a journey into deep time.

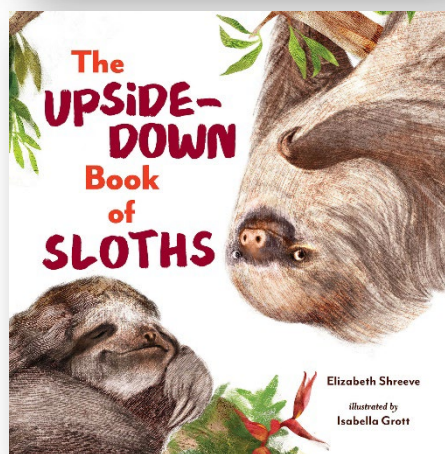
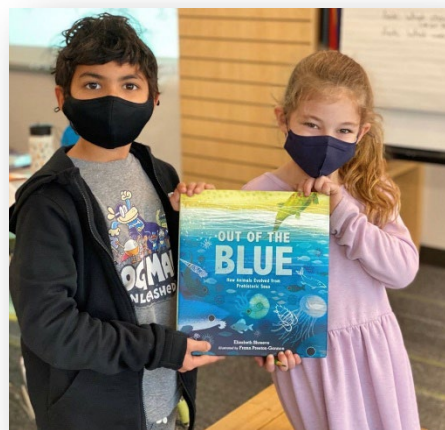
