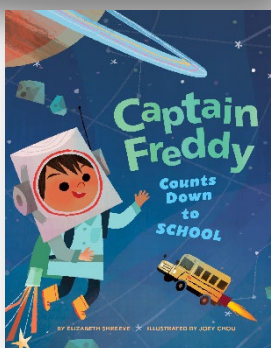
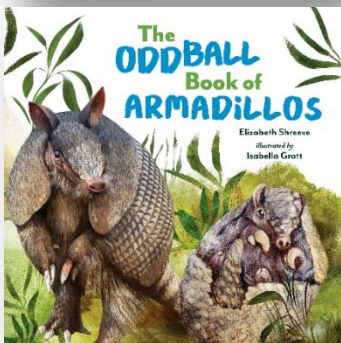
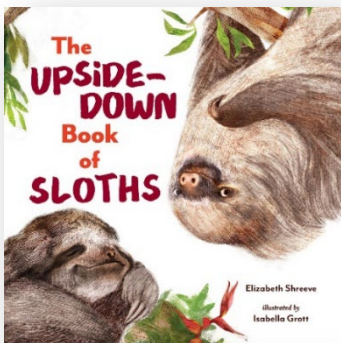


ELIZABETH SHREEVE - Author Visits

Puppets, fossils, giant sloths, and photos of adorable dogs included!



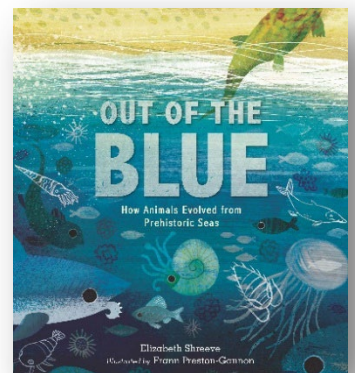
GRADES 2 TO 5:

THE UPSIDE-DOWN BOOK OF SLOTHS (Norton Young Readers, 2023). Who doesn't love sloths? Illustrated by Isabella Grott, this **Junior Library Guild** book for kids (ages 7-10) pairs and compares the slow-moving tree sloths of our times with their amazing ancestors. Program celebrates the biodiverse rainforests of South and Central America and includes step-by-step activities for students to develop their own creative projects.

THE ODDBALL BOOK OF ARMADILLOS (Norton Young Readers, September 3, 2024). Are they time-traveling dinosaurs? Giant walking seashells? No...they're ARMADILLOS, wonderful oddballs that have ambled through the Americas for millions of years. Did you know that armadillos are the official small mammal of Texas? In this action-packed program, we'll explore how armadillos and their enormous prehistoric relatives have adapted to changing conditions through time. Get ready to play the "Adaptation Game"!

GRADES 1 TO 4: OUT OF THE BLUE: HOW ANIMALS EVOLVED FROM PREHISTORIC SEAS (Candlewick Press, 2021). This beautifully illustrated, award-winning picture book takes kids on a journey into deep time. Presentation explains how writers undertake big topics and features top scientists who followed their childhood dreams. *Also in paperback (June 2024).*

GRADES PK-2/Story Time: CAPTAIN FREDDY COUNTS DOWN TO SCHOOL (Two Lions, 2016). It's Freddy's first day of school, and he needs to get ready. But school is far away and full of strangers. Luckily, Freddy remembers he has work to do—in space! This story time program explores the power of imagination and introduces the solar system.
